22. The Resolution of The Conflict on an Individual Basis.

- A. **Personal denial of the Conflict does not remove us from it.
Eph 6:10-13**
- B. **Mankind is not to be ignorant of Satan's schemes, so we need information about his motives and methods. 2 Cor 2:10-11; 11:3,13-15; 4:3-4**
- C. **The command is to "stand firm" against his methods and intentions.
Eph 6:13-18; 1 Pet 5:6-10**
- D. **Personal impact and survival requires the "Full Armor of God."
Eph 6:10-18**
 - 1. **This armor begins with a Divine Attitude and willingness to act. Eph 6:10**
 - 2. **Standing against the Devil requires the "Full Armor of God."
Eph 6:11**
 - 3. **We must embrace the fact we are in a battle. Eph 6:12**
 - 4. **God tells us to take up the armor to use. Eph 6:13**
 - 5. **Truth and (Experiential) Righteousness are primary defenses.
Eph 6:14**
 - 6. **The intent of the armor is to spread the good news. Eph 6:15**
 - 7. **God's Truth, believed and lived, can spiritually handle any situation. Eph 6:16**
 - 8. **The ability to "wage war" in the conflict comes from Eternal Security and Spiritual application of the Word of God. Eph 6:17**
 - a. **Our protection rests in the Security of our Salvation.**
 - b. **The primary offensive weapon is the Word of God, through which we are to spread the light without fear and with the same concern for others that God has. Eph 5:1; 1 Tim 2:4 Cf Php 2:3; 2 Tim 1:7**
 - 9. **Prayers are artillery in the Conflict. Eph 6:18**
- E. **Tremendous impact occurs by staying focused on the Two Greatest Commands. Mark 12:29-31**
- F. **To fulfill these commandments God and others must be first priority.
Php 2:3**
