- I. THE SAVIOR PRAYS FOR HIMSELF (17:1-5).
  - A. The faithful Son (17:1, 5)
    - 1. What he asks (17:1 a, 5): "Glorify your Son."
    - 2. Why he asks (17:1 b): "So he can give glory back to you."
  - B. The fruitful Son (17:2-5)
