The Feasts of Israel

1. Three times a year the men of Israel were required to present themselves before the Lord, during which time the Lord protected the land from invasion. Exo 34:21-24; 2 Chr 8:12-13
 - A. Assemblies:
 1. Feast of Unleavened Bread. Lev 23:4-14
 2. Feast of Pentecost. Lev 23:15-22
 3. Feast of Tabernacles. Lev 23:23-44
 - B. The timing of the feasts was based on Israel's agricultural economy and thus a call to remember their dependence on their Creator.
