Genesis 33:1-3 = The Time Has Come.

L.T. Then Jacob lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, Esau was coming, and four hundred men with him. So he divided the children among Leah and Rachel and the two maids. (2) He put the maids and their children in front, and Leah and her children next, and Rachel and Joseph last. (3) But he himself passed on ahead of them and bowed down to the ground seven times, until he came near to his brother.

Genesis 33:4 = The Unexpected.

L.T. Then Esau ran to meet him and embraced him, and fell on his neck and kissed him, and they wept.

Genesis 33:5 = Esau's First Question.

L.T. He lifted his eyes and saw the women and the children, and said, "Who are these with you?" So he said, "The children whom Elohim has graciously given your servant."

Genesis 33:6-8 = Introductions-Handmaids.

L.T. Then the maids came near with their children, and they bowed down. (7) Leah likewise came near with her children, and they bowed down; and afterward Joseph came near with Rachel, and they bowed down. (8) And he said, "What do you mean by all this company which I have met?" And he said, "To find grace in the sight of my adonay."

Principle: Unchecked fear leads to overdone "_____."

Genesis 33:9 = Esau's Unselfishness.

L.T. But Esau said, "I have plenty, my brother; let what you have be your own."

Principle: When fear controls discernment is _____.

Genesis 33:10 = Jacob's Fear.

L.T. Jacob said, "No, please, if now I have found grace in your sight, then take my gift offering from my hand, for I see your face as one sees the face of Elohim, and you have received me favorably.

Principle: Sometimes we become so _____ to complete our own plans that we fail to see God's plan.

Genesis 33:11= Jacob Trying to Appease.

L.T. "Please take my blessing which has been brought to you, because Elohim has dealt graciously with me and because I have plenty." Thus he urged him and he took.

Principle: Fix what you can but realize true _____ is from God and not man.

Genesis 33:12-14 = Esau the Protector.

L.T. Then Esau said, "Let us take our journey and go, and I will go before you." (13) But he said to him, "My adonay knows that the children are frail and that the flocks and herds which are nursing are a care to me. And if they are driven hard one day, all the flocks will die. (14) "Please let my adonay pass over before his servant, and I will guardingly lead according to my gentleness, according to the pace of the cattle that are before me and according to the pace of the children, until I come to my adonay at Seir."

Principle: Fear shuts down opportunities to _____.

Genesis 33:15 = Esau's Generosity.

L.T. Esau said, "Please let me leave with you some of the people who are with me." But he said, "What need is there? Let me find grace in the sight of my adonay."

Principle: Lies breed _____.

Genesis 33:16-17 = Esau Returns Home.

L.T. So Esau returned that day on his way to Seir. (17) Jacob journeyed to Succoth, and built for himself a house and made booths for his livestock; therefore the place is named Succoth.

Principle: "Successful" lies often lead to seeking other types of false _____.

Genesis 33:18-20 = Arrival at Shechem.

L.T. Now Jacob came safely to the city of Shechem, which is in the land of Canaan, when he came from Paddan-aram, and camped before the city. (19) He bought the piece of land where he had pitched his tent from the hand of the sons of Hamor, Shechem's father, for one hundred pieces of money. (20) Then he erected there an altar and called it El-Elohe-Israel.
