4:1 L.T./E.T. = I stand as your witness in the presence of God and of Messiah Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, even at His appearing and His kingdom (2) proclaim the word; presume victory in season and out of season; reprove falsehood; verbally rebuke; exhort with great patience toward people and doctrinal teaching.
