Personal Sins

1. The Sin Nature entices to three types of personal sin: Prov 6:16-19
2. All sin violates God's revealed law. Rom 4:15; 5:12-14
3. To "sin" is to "miss the mark." Contained within the designation "sin" are the designations "transgression" and "iniquity."
4. Personal Sins can be manifested in different ways, in varying degrees, or in rapid succession, like murder. Matt 5:21-23
5. Thus, sin is rebellion against part of God's Essence, specifically:
6. God told Moses that forgiveness for iniquity, transgression and sins were available from Him. Exo 34:6-8
7. Sins come from a lack of knowledge or faith in God's laws, so salvation is received through a saving knowledge of Jesus the Messiah, that is believed. Rom 3:21-27
