## Unashamed?

### 1 John 2:28 = Be Ready For The Rapture

E.T./L.T. = And now, little children, abide in Him so that when He may be manifested, we may have boldness and not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming.

#### Summary:

1. John refers to an event that all Believers must face. 2 Cor 5:5-10
2. We will stand before Him for our production to be evaluated. 1 Cor 3:10-16
3. Some will be disappointed and ashamed.
4. Shame can come from:

### 1 John 2:29 = The Righteous Children Of God (2:28 – 3:10)

E.T./L.T. = If you know from experience that He is righteous, you know that every one also who is practicing righteousness has been born of Him.

#### Summary:

1. Believers can learn our Lord is righteous through discipline. Heb 12:4-13
2. The foremost function of righteous conduct is love. 1 John 2:9-11
3. It is that which displays our new birth to others. John 13:34-35
4. It is the test to know experientially of your salvation. Cf 2:25; 5:13
5. Our love for God and others should lead us to obey His ethical and moral standards.

1. Those who are spiritually awake at the Rapture.
  2. Those who are unbelievers and do not get saved in the Tribulation will end up in the lake of fire.
  3. Those that know the Truth and do not teach it will lose a tremendous amount of rewards.
  4. Those that do not know the Truth and hence do not teach it will lose rewards, but have less discipline in time.
