Vigilance

2 John 1:8 = Get It All.

L.T./C.T. = Watch yourselves, that you might not ruin what we have accomplished, but that you may receive a full reward.

Summary:

1. Satan is the source of the lies concerning Jesus Christ. John 8:44
2. Beware of anyone who does not hold Jesus Christ in highest esteem as the Son of God.
3. Believers in any stage of maturity have to be on guard. 1 Cor 10:12
4. We are to look out for one another.
5. This type of leaven destroys corporate witness. Gal 5:7-10;
1 Cor 5:6-8
6. Love desires that others get the best of what the Lord offers.
Php 4:15-17
7. Ruining another person's work is spiritually costly.
8. With the encouragement to receive a full reward comes the implication that there are partial rewards.

Principle: Rewards are _____ to one another.

2 John 1:9 = The Importance of the Christian Life.

L.T./C.T. = All who go too far and are not abiding in the doctrine of the Christ, do not have God; the one who abides in the doctrine, he has both the Father and the Son.

Summary:

1. To receive the full reward, we must stay on track concerning what Christ has taught us to do.
2. The bulk of His personal description is found in the gospels with explanation, elaboration and application found in the rest of the New Testament.
3. Heretical teachings distort or deny what Christ taught. Cf 1 Tim 6:3
4. They go beyond the Word of God.
5. People who abandon the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ do not have a proper relationship with God.
6. They may not have God at all or they may miss the full measure of His blessing. John 13:8
7. A lifestyle focused on obedience to Christ's teaching leads to a full relationship with the Trinity. Cf John 14:23
