C.T./L.T. = Therefore (DIO), I shall always (MELLW) intend to remind (HUPOMIMN8SKW) you of these things, even though you *already* know *them*, and have been established (ST8RIDZW) in the present (PAROUSIA) truth.

1. From the information in 1:2-9, Peter has drawn a personal application for others (be all the more diligent) and for himself.
2. These principles are so important that he makes no apologies for repeating them.
3. Principle: A teacher of God's truth should seek to find the important things, teach them and repeat them so that no one forgets them.
