## The Resurrection of the Messiah

## 2 Pet 1:19 = The Sure Prophetic Word.

C.T./L.T. = So we have (ECHW) more firm (BEBAIOTEROS) the prophetic word (PROPH8TIKOS + LOGOS) to which you are doing well paying attention (PROSECHW) to as a lamp shining in a miserable (AUXMEROS) place until a day may shine through (DIAUGUDZW) and a bringer of light (PHWSPHOROS) may arise (ANATELLW) in your hearts.

### Summary:

1. The prophetic word is made more \_\_\_\_\_ by the fact of Christ's fulfillment of various prophecies.
2. To "pay attention" to this Word is part of "doing well," which involves:

#### 1 Cor 15:1 = The Importance of the Gospel.

C.T./L.T. = Now I make know to you (GNWRIDZW), brethren, the Gospel which I myself preached to you, which also you received (PARALAMBANW), in which also you stand (HIST8MI),

#### 1 Cor 15:2 = The Gospel Has Content.

C.T./L.T. = through (DIA) which (Gospel) also you are being preserved *from danger* (SWDZW), if you hold fast (EI + KATECHW) to that word (TIS + LOGOS) which I preached to you, unless you believed (PISTEUW) in nothing (EKTOS).

#### Summary:

1. Paul is addressing Believers and reminding them how they were initially saved.
2. The Gospel was heard, understood, and believed at a point of time which produced lasting results. (Aorist Tense)

3. The Object of the Faith, Jesus the Messiah, is the One who saves, not the simple ability to believe something.
4. If they did not believe in Jesus as Messiah, they believed in nothing.
5. Once saved, the Gospel must continue to be understood, believed, and held onto as a firm foundation, in order to preserve a person from the danger of spiritual error.
6. It will then preserve from sin and spiritual error in time as a Believer is delivered from the power of sin. Col 2:6-7
7. Faith in the Person and Work of Jesus Christ is essential to salvation, both from the Penalty for Sin and the Power of Sin.
8. Therefore, the Gospel is the ongoing foundation of the Christian life.

Principle: The Gospel is the basis of deliverance for \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

Principle: Sometimes even Believers need to be reminded of their salvation, especially after receiving multiple \_\_\_\_\_.

### 1 Cor 15:3 = The First Crucial Element of the Gospel.

C.T./L.T. = For I delivered to you as of first importance (EN + PROTOS) what I also received (PARALAMBANW), that Christ died (APOTHN8SKW) on behalf of our sins (HUPER + HAMARTIA) according to the Scriptures,

#### Summary:

1. Paul brought the Gospel to the Corinthians just as he received it.
2. The first crucial element of the Gospel is that Messiah took our place concerning the death penalty that was due for our sins.  
Rom 6:23; Col 2:13-15
3. It only takes one sin to make one worthy of condemnation. Jas 2:10
4. Sin is anything that falls short of the glory of God. Rom 3:23
5. But the Sin Nature, passed through the man to his offspring, is also sufficient to condemn, so man has a twofold problem. Rom 5:12-15
6. Christ means the "Anointed One," the Messiah, the One who would deliver from sins and thus a clear-cut means is required to identify Him.
7. Messiah would be the Son of God and the son of David. Psa 110:1
8. Many prophecies are used to identify the "Coming One." Gen 49:10
9. The Scriptures foretold His death, even death on a cross. Psa 22; Isa 53
10. Adam died two "deaths" that were the result of eating from the forbidden tree, spiritually (immediately) and physically (950 years later). Gen 2:16-17
11. Jesus Christ died more than one death to take care of all the sin problems caused by Adam at the Fall of Man. Isa 53:9
12. He who knew no sin became sin for us. 2 Cor 5:21
13. The faith that saves includes the facts that Jesus was the One who died on the cross to pay for the sin problems of His creation. Col 1:20
14. Many people spend their lives trying to pay for their own sins, thus not experiencing the deliverance and peace that Messiah has already given.

15. Many people spend their lives living in slavery to sins that have been paid for without seeing the escape from them that is available.

Principle: An offer of salvation that does not present the issue of \_\_\_\_\_ is not The Gospel. Cf Gal 1:6-8

1 Cor 15:4 = The Second and Third Crucial Elements.

C.T./L.T. = and that He was buried (THAPTW), and that He was raised (EGEIRW) on the third day, according to the Scriptures.

Summary:

1. Paul is dealing with crucial elements of the Gospel.
2. The second crucial element is that He was buried, which is further evidence that He really died.
  - A. This fact was attested by all the eyewitnesses and authorities.
  - B. If He did not die then some of the issue of sin(s) might still need to be considered.
3. The third crucial element is that He was permanently raised on the third day.
  - A. Peter was an eyewitness to this fact and proclaimed it on the Day of Pentecost. Acts 2:25-32
  - B. The "Third Day" is the Sign of the Prophet Jonah, which is a specific prophetic fulfillment. Matt 12:38-42
4. The Scriptures attest to the historicity of these events as does ancient history.

Principle: Messiah's burial and Resurrection are \_\_\_\_\_ to the Gospel.
