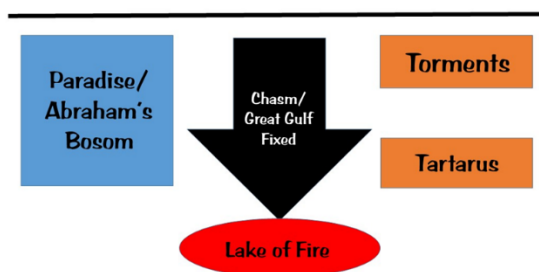
2 Pet 2:4 = Angels Were Not Immune.

C.T./L.T. = For if the God did not spare (OUK + PHEIDOMAI) angels when they sinned (HAMARTANW), but cast them to Tartarus (TARTAROW) and committed (PARADIDWMI) them to pits of darkness (SEIRA + ZOPHOS), being guarded (T8REW + EIS + KRISIS) into judgment;

C.T./L.T. 2:5 = and did not spare (PHEIDOMAI) the ancient world (ARCHAIOS + KOSMOS) but preserved (PHULASSW) Noah, a herald (K8RUX) of righteousness (DIKAI8SUN8), an eighth, when He brought (EPAGW) a flood (KATAKLUSMOS) upon the world of the ungodly (ASEB8S),

C.T./L.T. = and if He condemned (KATAKRINW) the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah to overthrow (KATASTOPH8) by reducing them to ashes (TEPHROW), having made them an example (HUPODEIGMA) to those who would live ungodly thereafter,

1 Cor 15:20 = The Historical Truth.

C.T./L.T. = But now Christ has been raised (EGEIRW) out of (EK) the dead (NEKROS), the first fruits (APARCH8) from the dead of those who are asleep (KOIMAW).

1 Cor 15:21 = The Theological Truth.

C.T./L.T. = For since by a man *came* death (THANATOS), by a man also came the resurrection (ANASTASIS) of the dead (NEKROS).

1 Cor 15:22 = The Theological Reason.

C.T./L.T. = For as in the Adam they all die (APOTHN8SKW), so also in Christ they all shall be made alive (ZWOPOIEW).

Summary:

1. Jesus Christ has been raised with lasting results.
2. He is the literal fulfillment of the shadow of the Feast of First-Fruits which also teaches the principle of bringing the first fruit of one's offerings to the Lord. Exo 23:14-17; 34:26; Num 18:12-13
3. Christ is the best offering and thus the prototype for Resurrection.
4. Christ died to identify with and pay for the sin of Adam that was passed to every member of the human race. Rom 5:12-14
5. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit have a part in the Resurrection of Messiah. Rom 4:17; John 5:21; John 6:63
6. Christ's Resurrection guarantees that all will be resurrected to eternal life.
7. Some to spend eternity with God, some eternity away from God. Rev 20:6,11-14
8. Some will possess eternal life, but fail to partake of the good parts of this life because of it.

Promise: Everyone in Christ shall receive new life of a _____ unlike any other.

1 Cor 15:23 = The Groom and the Bride.

C.T./L.T. = But each in his own order (TAGMA): Christ the first fruits (APARCH8), after that those who are Christ's at His coming (PAROUSIA),

Summary:

- 1. The Resurrection is the result of an orderly plan, designed by God.**
- 2. The "Commander of the Armies" was the first to be raised.**
- 3. His armies will be next. Rev 19:11-16**
- 4. The first stage of this resurrection group is at the Rapture which precedes the outpouring of wrath during the Tribulation. 1 Thes 1:10; Rev 3:10; 4:1 cf 19:7-10**
- 5. Stage 1 is for "those who are His," namely, the Church, the Bride of Christ. 1 Thes 2:19; 3:13; 4:15; 5:23; Jas 5:7-8; 1 John 2:28**
- 6. Stage 2 is specifically said to be after the Tribulation at the Second Advent. Dan 12:1-4,13**
- 7. Stage 2 would include Believers from the Age of the Gentiles and the Age of Israel.**
- 8. The Resurrection was known and taught at the earliest recorded times in human history. Job 19:23-29**

1 Cor 15:24 = The Subjects of the King.

C.T./L.T. = then *comes* the end (TELOS), when He delivers up (PARADIDWMI) the kingdom to the God even Father, when He has rendered inoperative (KATERGEW) all rule (ARCH8) and all authority (EXOUSIA) and power (DUNAMIS).

1 Cor 15:25 = The Length of the Reign.

C.T./L.T. = For He is obligated (DEI) to reign (BASILEUW) until He has put (TITH8MI) all His enemies (ECHTHROS) under His feet.

1 Cor 15:26 = The Ultimate Victory.

C.T./L.T. = The last enemy (ESCHATOS + ECHTHROS) to be rendered inoperative (KATERGEW) is the death.

1 Cor 15:27 = Explanation Of Divine Timing.

C.T./L.T. = FOR HE HAS PUT ALL THINGS IN SUBJECTION (HUPOTASSW) UNDER HIS FEET. But when He says, "All things are eternally subjected (HUPOTASSW)," it is evident that He is excepted who put all things in subjection to Him.

Promise: The Lord will _____ all things to Himself.

1 Cor 15:28 = Eternal Authority.

C.T./L.T. = And when (HOTAN) all things are subjected (HUPOTASSW) to Him, then the Son Himself also will be subjected (HUPOTASSW) to the One who subjected all things to Him, that the God may be all in all.

Summary:

1. **“The End” must refer to the end of the Angelic Conflict, after the Millennial Kingdom when unbelievers are cast into the Lake of Fire. Rev 20:11-15**
2. **There will be some “enemy rulers” surface after the Millennium. Rev 20:7-10**
3. **The Saints will rule with Him for the thousand year Millennial Kingdom. Rev 20:6**
4. **As the Resurrection occurs in stages, so does Christ’s rule.**
 - A. **Stage 1 is from the Ascension to the Second Advent. Eph 1:18-23**
 - B. **The Stage 1 rule of Messiah is from heaven. Psa 110:1**
 - C. **Stage 2 of His rule is from the Second Advent until the end of the Millennium on earth. Psa 110:2**
 - D. **Stage 2 will culminate by crushing the Gog/Magog rebellion. Rev 20:7-10**
 - E. **Next will be the Resurrection of the Millennial saints, who entered the Millennium in human bodies but still were subject to death and died. Matt 25:31-46**
 - F. **The Final Stage of His rule will be eternal, in His Hypostatic Union, still under the authority of His Father. Rev 21:4-7**
5. **Death is the biggest enemy that the Lord will defeat, which will be abolished after the Gog/Magog rebellion.**
 - A. **To defeat death required the defeat of sin. Rom 6:23**
 - B. **Resurrection is the proof that death is defeated. Rev 21:4**
 - C. **Thus, Jesus Christ holds the "keys to Death and Hades." Rev 1:17-18**
6. **The “all things” to “subject” includes creatures, events, and the Church. Eph 1:22; 1 Pet 3:22**
7. **He must display His “control of history” to bring about the prophesied and promised events over the specified period of time while still permitting volition to exist.**
8. **These verses indicate that Messiah’s glorified humanity plays a significant role in the Angelic Conflict.**
9. **To “be all in all” looks at the completeness of being “filled up to all the fulness of God” for all of eternity. Eph 3:14-19**

Principle: Without the Resurrection there is no reason for _____ to exist.
