2 Pet 2:13 = Stains And Blemishes Are Deceptive.

C.T./L.T. = receiving unrighteousness as a wage (MISTHOS) of unrighteousness (ADIKIA) considering the luxury (TRUPH8) in that day as pleasure (H8DON8). Stains (SPILOS) and blemishes (MWMOS) *are they*, living luxuriously in their deceptions (ENTRUPHAW + APAT8), being entertained with you (SUNEUCHEOMAI),

Summary:

1. Part of their discipline will come from one another
2. These False Teachers are Hedonists, pleasure-seekers, who seek the luxury of their day, as a king would. Luke 7:25
3. The rich of the last days are known for their luxurious living at the expense of others. Jas 5:1-6
4. Salvation is designed to deliver us from Hedonistic activity. Titus 3:3-7
5. But Hedonism can easily choke us so that no fruit is produced. Luke 8:14
6. Hedonism is often the source of quarrels and conflicts and will most certainly affect our prayers Jas 4:1-3
7. These False Teachers are entertained by those who listen and follow them. Jude 1:12-13
8. “Stains” looks at problems that come from outside thus participating in the things of the world, while “blemishes” look at the flaws from inside, thus concerning character.

C.T./L.T. = having eyes full (MESTOS) of adultery (MOICHALIS) and that never cease from sin (AKATAPAUSTOS + HAMARTIA), seducing (DELEADZW) unstable souls (ASTRIKTOS), having a heart trained (GUMNADZW) in covetousness (PLEONEXIA), accursed children (KATARA + TEKNA) ,

1. In addition to the luxurious life of the false teachers, gained by deception and viewing others as a source of entertainment, these people have other flaws.

The Importance of The Resurrection

1 Cor 15:39 = There Are Bodily Differences By Design.

C.T./L.T. = All flesh is not the same flesh, but there is one (ALL8) flesh of men, and another (ALL8) flesh of beasts, and another (ALL8) flesh of birds, and another (ALL8) of fish.

1 Cor 15:40 = There Are Heavenly Differences By Design.

C.T./L.T. = There are also heavenly bodies (SWMA) and earthly bodies, but the glory (DOXA) of the heavenly is one, and the glory of the earthly is another (HETEROS).

1 Cor 15:41 = For Example.

C.T./L.T. = There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for star differs from star in glory.

Summary:

- 1. God's creation displays the fact that He made different kinds of flesh that are similar to each other, but different.**
- 2. He also made heavenly forms with varying degrees of brilliance.**
- 3. Creation itself is a picture of God's Omniscience, being able to make so many things that are similar and yet different, and also totally different.**
- 4. One day He will change all of these things.**

Principle: God's creative ability is _____.

1 Cor 15:42 = The Spiritual Application-The First Difference.

C.T./L.T. = So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown (SPEIRW) in corruption (EN + PHTHORA), it is raised in incorruption (EN + APHTHARSIA);

Summary:

- 1. Having demonstrated God's ability to create and make a multitude of people and things, Paul applies it to the future.**
- 2. He begins to answer the question, "what kind of body?" Cf 15:35**
- 3. The eternal life that God offers is not simply eternal existence, but rather eternal incorruptibility.**
- 4. This is crucial to the gospel. 2 Tim 1:10**
- 5. Our response should be an incorruptible love. Eph 6:24**

1 Cor 15:43 = Two More Differences.

C.T./L.T. = it is sown in dishonor (ATIMIA), it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power;

1 Cor 15:44 = Another Difference and The Conclusion.

C.T./L.T. = it is sown a natural body (PSUCHIKOS), it is raised a spiritual body (PNEUMATIKOS). If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body.

Summary:

1. Our old bodies are:
 - A. Corrupted from our beginning.
 - B. Separated from God.
 - C. Lacking strength.
 - D. Lacking the Holy Spirit.
2. Our new bodies will be:
 - A. Incorruptible.
 - B. Glorified.

Principle: Having to die in order to be raised means we cannot do these things apart from _____ help.

1 Cor 15:45 = Transitions.

C.T./L.T. = So also it is written, “The first man, Adam, BECAME (GINOMAI + EIS) A LIVING SOUL (PSUCH8).” The last Adam became a life-giving (ZWOPOIEW) spirit.

Summary:

1. The first purely human body was made from dust that God had created.
Gen 2:7
2. God breathed into his nostrils the “breath of lives” (NESHEMAH CHAYYIM) and the man became a living being, now having a soul.
3. From the curse later placed on and in Adam for his Fall, humanity receives Adam’s original sin which brings with it corruption, separation from God, and physical weakness. Rom 5:12
4. The Last Adam, Jesus Christ, was uniquely born and based on His life and acts received the authority, in now glorified hypostatic union to give life.
5. This is something that The Law could never do. Gal 3:21
6. The Father is involved in raising the dead and giving them life.
John 5:21-24; Rom 4:17
7. The Son is the determiner of who is made alive, based on righteous judgment, namely obedience to the Gospel. 1 Cor 15:22
8. The Holy Spirit is the actual agent of Resurrection.
John 6:63; Rom 8:11; 2 Cor 3:6; 1 Pet 3:18

Principle: The Trinity works _____ to Resurrect.

1 Cor 15:46 = The Divine Order.

C.T./L.T. = However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural (PSUCHIKOS); then the spiritual (PNEUMATIKOS).

1 Cor 15:47 = The Theology.

C.T./L.T. = The first man is from earth, earthy; the second man is from heaven.

Summary:

- 1. Adam was made from elements from the earth. Gen 2:7**
- 2. Jesus Christ came from heaven. John 6:51**

1 Cor 15:48 = The Contrasts.

C.T./L.T. = As is the earthy, so also are those who are earthy; and as is the heavenly, so also are those who are heavenly.

Summary:

- 1. Those born in Adam are of the earth.**
- 2. Those born into Christ are now heavenly.**

1 Cor 15:49 = The Logical Conclusion.

C.T./L.T. = And just as we have worn (PHOREW) the image (EIKWN) of the earthy, we shall also wear the image of the heavenly.

Summary:

- 1. With our physical birth we wear the image of Adam.**
- 2. With our new birth we begin the transformation into the image of Jesus Christ. 2 Cor 3:18; Col 3:10**
- 3. It will reach its full potential at the Resurrection. Php 1:6; Php 3:20-21; Col 3:4**
- 4. This new body will be like The Lord Jesus Christ. 1 John 3:2**
