### 2 Pet 3:11 = Faith For Today.

C.T./L.T. = Since all these things are going to be dissolved (LUW) in this way, what sort of (POTAPOS) people is it obligated (DEI) to you to begin to be (HUPARCHW) in holy (HAGIOS) behavior (ANASTROPH8) and godliness (EUSEBEIA)?

### 2 Pet 3:12 = Hope For Tomorrow.

C.T./L.T. = eagerly expecting (PROSDOKAW) and earnestly desiring (SPEUDW) the coming (PAROUSIA) of the day of the God, on account of which the heavens will be dissolved (LUW) by burning, and the elements burning up totally are going to be melted down. (KAUSOMAI + T8KW)

### 2 Pet 3:13 = His Promise For Eternity.

C.T./L.T. 3:13 = But (DE) according to His promise we are eagerly expecting (PROSDOKAW) new (KAINOS) heavens and a new earth in which righteousness (DIKAIOSUN8) dwells (KATOIKEW).

### 2 Pet 3:14 = The Principle.

C.T./L.T. = Therefore (DIO), beloved (AGAP8TOS), since you are eagerly expecting (PROSDOKAW) these things, be diligent (SPOUDADZW) to be found (EURISKW) by Him in peace (EIR8N8), unstained (ASPILOS) and without ceremonial impurity (AMWM8TOS).
