Matt 2:13-23 Escape to Egypt

1. Jesus' Birth: Introduction
 - A. Preparation for His birth
 - B. A New Born King is Worshipped
10. Escape to Egypt Matt 2:13-23

Matt 2:13 = Divine Guidance for Joseph-Four Commands.

Now when they (**The Magi**) had departed, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared (**Pres Mid Ind PHAINW**) to Joseph in a dream, saying, "Arise and take the Child (**PAIDION**) and His mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there until I tell you; for Herod is going to search for the Child to destroy Him."

Matt 2:14 = Joseph's Obedience

And he arose and took the Child and His mother by night, and departed for Egypt;

Matt 2:15 = Another Prophecy Fulfilled

and was there until the death of Herod, that what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet might be fulfilled, saying, "Out of Egypt did I call My Son." (**Exo 4:22-23 cf Hos 11:1**)

Matt 2:16 = Herod's Vicious Anger

Then when Herod saw that he had been tricked (**Aor Pas Ind EMPAIDZW**) by the magi, he became very enraged (**Aor Pas Ind THUMOW**), and sent (**APOSTELLW**) and slew all the male children who were in Bethlehem and in all its environs, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had ascertained (**AKRIBOW**) from the magi.

Matt 2:17 = Another Prophecy Fulfilled

Then that which was spoken through Jeremiah the prophet was fulfilled, saying,

Matt 2:18 = The Content of Jeremiah's Prophecy (Jer 31:15)

"A voice was heard in Ramah, Weeping and great mourning,
Rachel weeping for her children; And she refused to be comforted,
Because they were no more."

Matt 2:19 = More Divine Guidance

But when Herod was dead, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, saying,

Matt 2:20 = Specifics-Three Commands

"Arise and take the Child and His mother, and go into the land of Israel; for those who sought the Child's life are dead."

Matt 2:21 = Obedience—Again

And he arose and took the Child and His mother, and came into the land of Israel.

Matt 2:22 = More Instructions and Wisdom

But when he heard that Archelaus was reigning over Judea in place of his father Herod, he was afraid (**Aor Pas Ind PHOBEW**) to go there. And being warned by God in a dream, he departed for the regions of Galilee,

Matt 2:23 = And Still More Prophecy (Isa 9:6; 11:1)

and came and resided in a city called Nazareth, that what was spoken through the prophets might be fulfilled, "He shall be called a Nazarene (**Isa 9:6; 11:1-2**)."

Summary:

- 1. There is no indication that Jesus took the Nazarite Vow, like His cousin John.
- 2. The term "Nazarene" indicated His home city rather than one who had taken the vow. Mark 14:67; 16:6; Luke 24:19; John 18:5,7; 19:19 et al

 - 1). A Missing Child Luke 2:41-52

Luke 2:41 = Family Time

And His parents (**GONEUS**) used to go to Jerusalem every year at the Feast of the Passover.

Luke 2:42 = Jesus at Twelve Years of Age

And when He became twelve, they went up there according to the custom of the Feast;

Luke 2:43 = Jesus Stays

and as they were returning, after spending the full number of days, the boy Jesus stayed behind (**HUPOMENW**) in Jerusalem. And His parents were unaware (**OUK + Aor Act Ind GINWSKW**) of it,

Luke 2:44 = The Family's Discovery

but supposed Him to be in the caravan (**SUNODIA**), and went a day's journey; and they began looking for Him among their relatives (**SUGGENES**) and acquaintances (**GNWSTOS**).

Luke 2:45 = The Return to Jerusalem

And when they did not find Him, they returned to Jerusalem, looking for Him.

Luke 2:46 = Jesus the Student

And it came about that after three days they found Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them, and asking them questions. (**why didn't they look there first?**)

Luke 2:47 = Jesus the Prodigy

And all who heard Him were amazed (**IPF Act Ind EXIST8MI**) at His understanding (**SUNESIS**) and His answers (**APOKRISIS**).

Luke 2:48 = Mary's Question

And when they saw Him, they were astonished (**EKPLESSW**); and His mother said to Him, "Son, why have You treated us this way (**POIEW = done this to us**)? Behold, Your father and I have been anxiously (**grieving while seeking**) looking for You."

Luke 2:49 = Jesus' Response

And He said to them, "Why is it that you were looking for Me? Did you not know that I had to be in My Father's house?"

Luke 2:50 = The Teachers' Confusion

And they did not understand (**OU + Aor Act Ind SUNIEMI**) the statement (**RH8MA**) which He had made to them.

Luke 2:51 = Life in Nazareth

And He went down with them, and came to Nazareth; and He continued in subjection (**Pres Pas Ptc HUPOTASSW**) to them; and His mother treasured (**IPF Act Ind DIATEREW**) all these things in her heart.

Luke 2:52 = Jesus' Growth

And Jesus kept increasing (**IPF Act Ind PROKOPTW**) in wisdom (**SOPHIA**) and stature (**H8LIKIA**), and in favor (**CHARIS**) with God and men.

Summary:

- 1. Mary and Joseph frantically search for Jesus throughout the caravan, the road back to Jerusalem, and the city.**
