22. Be Vigilant: Ready to guard.

Vigilance: Watchful, observant and alert. The ability to maintain attention and alertness over prolonged periods of time. Perseverance is part of it. This is derived from the Imperative of BLEPW, often translated "Take Heed," and means to "Be On The Lookout (BOLO)." (Matt 24:4; Mark 4:24; 8:15; 12:38; 13:5,9,23; Luke 8:18; 21:8; Acts 13:40; 1 Cor 8:9; 10:18; 16:10; Gal 5:15; Eph 5:15; Php 3:2 (3x); Col 2:8; 4:17; Heb 3:12; 12:25; 2 John 8)
