Jude 1:21 = The Key Command. Command 3

C.T./L.T. = Keep yourselves (Aor Act Imp T8REW) in the love of God, waiting anxiously (Pres Mid Ptc PROSDECHOMAI) for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life.

22. Be Vigilant: Ready to guard.

Vigilance: Watchful, observant and alert. The ability to maintain attention and alertness over prolonged periods of time. Perseverance is part of it. This is derived from the Imperative of BLEPW, often translated “Take Heed,” and means to “Be On The Lookout (BOLO).” (Matt 24:4; Mark 4:24; 8:15; 12:38; 13:5,9,23; Luke 8:18; 21:8; Acts 13:40; 1 Cor 8:9; 10:18; 16:10; Gal 5:15; Eph 5:15; Php 3:2 (3x); Col 2:8; 4:17; Heb 3:12; 12:25; 2 John 8)
