"I am the true vine (**AMPELOS** = a grape vine + **AL8THINOS** = genuine, real), and My Father is the vinedresser (**GEWRGOS** = farmer).

John 15:2 = Relationships

"Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away (**AIRW** = lifts up; can be to take away, but the emphasis is on the lifting up); and every branch that bears fruit, He prunes (**KATHAIREW** = cut based on a standard) it so that it may bear more fruit.
