

## **Two Sides To The Coin The Question and the Logical Solution.**

### **Two Possibilities:**

It is logical to assume that someone or something has always been eternal, for without a cause there would be no effect. The only two possibilities are that either there is an eternal being or matter is eternal. It makes more sense to believe that a personal, thinking being brought forth an impersonal thing than to believe that an impersonal, unthinking thing brought forth a personal being.

### **Two Decisions:**

Choose to follow your own path of religious salvation of oneself, knowing that it may never be good enough and remain a slave to that futile quest or believe upon the One who died on a cross for your sins, was buried, and rose again. Jesus' tomb is empty.

### **Two Possible Outcomes:**

There is only two possible outcomes. Either accept the only qualified Savior and spend eternity with Him in heaven or reject Him and spend eternity in hell.
